3D2412: Bronze Casting with John Hallett

A supply fee for consumables, including wax, slurry, bronze, and propane, is paid at the end of class. The exact cost depends on the amount of each material used and the cost of bronze at the time of the workshop.

Required Materials:

- An idea for a sculpture up to 10" in any direction
- Hard-soled work boots
- 2 bandanas
- Dishwashing gloves
- Dust mask or respirator
- Work jeans
- Safety glasses
- Leather work gloves
- Ear plugs
- Old utensils, such as butter knives, forks, dental tools, metal picks, etc for carving wax.

For ALL classes, remember to bring:

- Sketchbook and pencil for sketching and notetaking
- Comfortable shoes and/or a rubber mat for cement studio floors
- Apron or smock
- Sweater; studios are air conditioned

The items listed above are recommended by the instructor. You may be asked to bring more than you will actually use. The acquisition and cost of these items are your responsibility.
